Injury Characteristics:

- 65% Traumatic Brain Injuries (MVA, Falls, Gunshot wounds)
- 35% Acquired Brain Injuries (includes Encephalitis & Anoxia)
- 18% Admitted with additional medical conditions including insulin dependent diabetes, seizure disorders, metabolic disorders, and/or pre-injury mood disorders

Discharge Disposition

- 75% Home
- 25% Institution (Assisted Living Facility, Hospital)

Average Length of Treatment:

- Post Acute Rehab Program: 93.5 days
- Supported Living Program: 4 years (range 1 month-7.5 years)

OUTCOME HIGHLIGHTS:

- 90% of Client and Family respondents report overall satisfaction with services
- 90% of Client and Family Consumers perceived improvement upon completion of treatment
- 90% of Consumers state they will recommend Restore Neurobehavioral Center to others
